On **Saturday, September 23<sup>th</sup>, 2017**, the Haunt Rater and his crew visited Laurel's House of Horror. When visiting a haunt for the first time, you never know what to expect. Will it be worth it, just how scary will it be, will it live up to its name, does it know how to deliver true terror? These are just some of the questions we ask ourselves in preparation for such a visit. Well, we have to admit that we were in no way disappointed with our experience. See our review below!

There are no words to describe just how they properly set the scene. As we waited for our turn to enter the attraction we had no idea what to think and then out of nowhere, a monster appears and surprises you from the beginning leading us to believe that we were definitely in for the ride of our lives! We entered the theatre which was perfectly set up to create the perfect atmos**FEAR**! Then as we waited to enter the next part of the haunt, another monster met us and started us on our way to a night that we would not soon forget.

As we departed and left any feelings of safety behind, we quickly began to realize that this attraction is not for the faint of heart. While the use of animatronics can be seen, they had just the perfect amount to distract you from the real horror that awaited your presence. As we winded through twists and turns, it was very difficult to anticipate where our next fright would come from. Just when we thought we could anticipate the next move or where the next scare would come from, we were totally taken off guard by some evil lurking in the darkest of corners.

We were taken from one scene to the next, not knowing what was in store but, each one more terrifying than the last.
