On **Saturday, October 28th, 2017**, the Haunt Rater and his crew went south, down to Georgetown, Delaware to see our good friends at "**Screams at the Beach**"! It is one of our longer travels but, it is well worth it. This year they have redesigned their attractions while also adding two new Escape Rooms.

We started our night by completing 2 escape rooms! They were AMAZING!!! Horror+Grotesque+Clues=ONE AWESOME EXPERIENCE! We first started with **Escape: Dissection**. We were given 10 minutes to escape, 6 clues, and we had to get out before they got in! Lights were on and off constantly, making our ability to read the clues, harder and harder. Finding each clue got even harder than the next, making our nervous rattle more than ever before.

Next we tried "Escape: Serial K2 Kitchen" which was even better. We had 10 minutes to figure out all 6 clues to be able to unlock the door before it was too late. We had to reach inside a dead body, reach inside a severed head and other ghastly places. A ghoul was inside awaiting us, as we opened one of the clues. We were able to escape but, barely with our lives!

Next we were taken to "Escape the Crimson Woods". Not more than a few seconds into beginning our journey, the ghouls and ghosts of the night were coming after us, showing us who was in charge! The Crimson Woods are a dark and highly terrifying place and while you may be in the safety of a wagon, we can sincerely promise that you are not safe by any means. As you make your way through the woods, you are dropped off at "Abomination Acres".

"Abomination Acres" is a place where your senses are taken away and true you walk with nothing but, the feeling of horror. Never knowing what lurks around each corner, you make your way, praying for a way out but, never knowing when it will actually come. After finishing, making our way out of Abomination Acres, we got back onto the wagon to finish our Escape of the Crimson Woods.

We then were escorted to "Cemetery of Sorrows" which was a terrifying place to be. Zombies of all kinds and undead souls chased us throughout our journey. No matter where we went or how hard we tried to get away, there was always someone there waiting to take us, making us their next meal. We never thought we would ever get out in one piece. The Cemetery of Sorrows is not for the light hearted.

Next was the "House of the Hollow". That place is crazy insane! Your mind is literally tortured, your soul taken captive, in the hopes of making you the next soul to haunt its Hallowed Halls. The ghouls inside never rest and that is made apparent by the way they never let up on us. You want to experience the best scares out there? Well, this is the attraction to partake in. You will definitely come out scared, praying for the light at the end of the tunnel but, even your prayers cannot be heard in that kind of HELL!

After surviving that experience, we got to experience "**Pandemonium**" which is all out CHAOS! Want to know what HELL is like? Well, here you can get a taste of what it must be like to live in a state of horror for the rest of eternity and forcing each victim that enters within to taste of it as well. There is no doubt that we tasted that HELL and not only was it literally terrifying but, it was also soul draining. Run, walk or hide, but, there is no way to escape their grasp!

The final attraction of the evening that we were able to experience was the all new "**Prison of the Plague**"! This place is INSANELY SCARY and INSANELY AWESOME!
